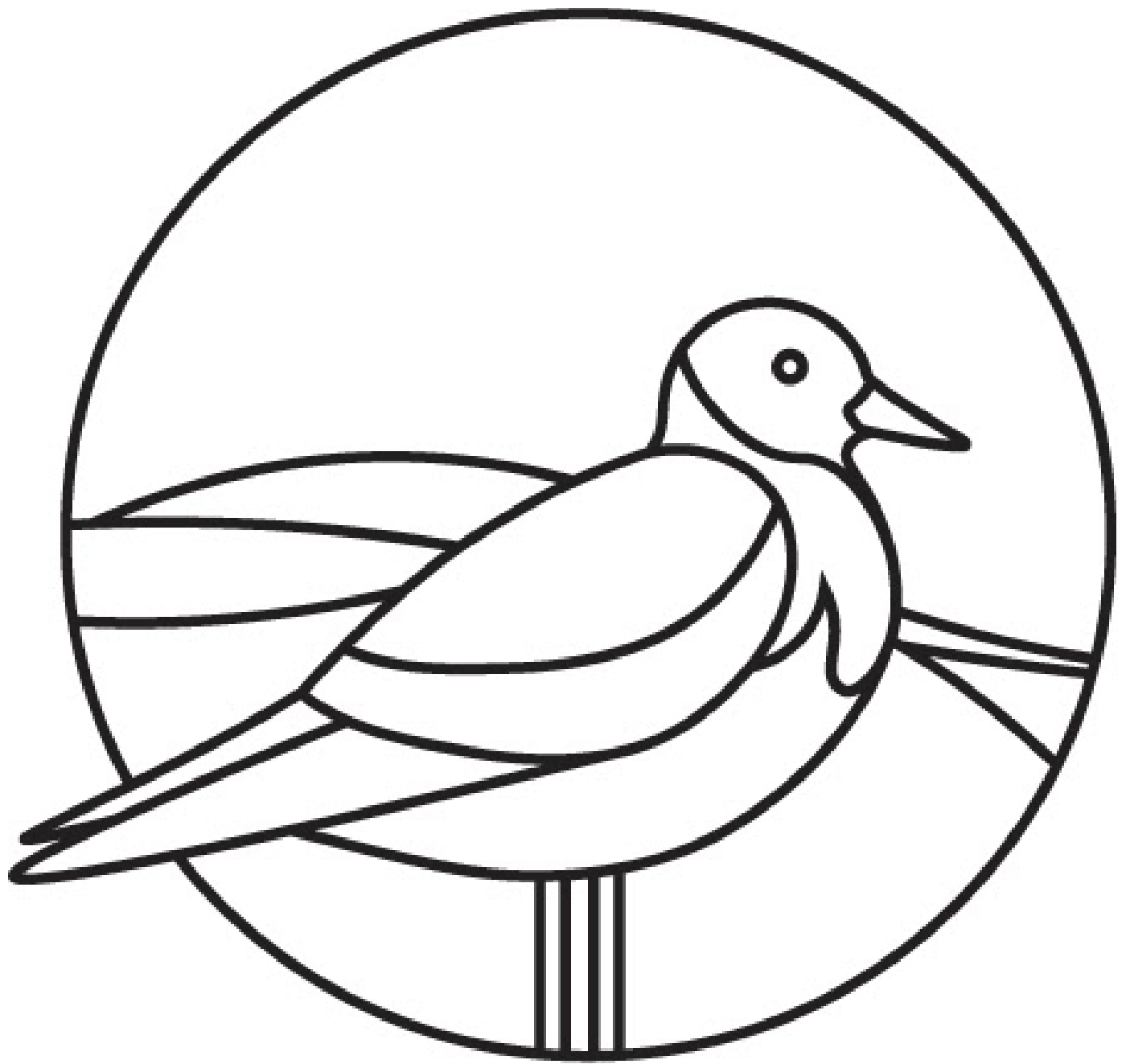


FABRIC COLLAGE

Fabric scraps can be used for beautiful art pieces if you know how to use them! In this activity, you'll use these home decorator fabric samples to create animals in collage form.

1. Use one of the line drawings of animals provided, or find one of your own on the internet! Trace the outline of your animal onto cardboard, and cut out the whole piece. This will serve as your base to glue fabric to.
2. Cut along all the lines of your animal, making sure to keep all the pieces in their proper place. If they get mixed up, it might be a little puzzling but you'll figure out where they go!
3. Use the pieces to trace onto your fabric, then cut and glue!
4. Experiment with different textures, patterns, and layering different fabrics for different effects.
5. Want a challenge? Try drawing your own piece, then collaging it with fabric! Hang your masterpieces on the wall with a command strip, use it as a fancy bookmark, or attach it to a canvas for a more finished piece.
