

Color Exploration Activity

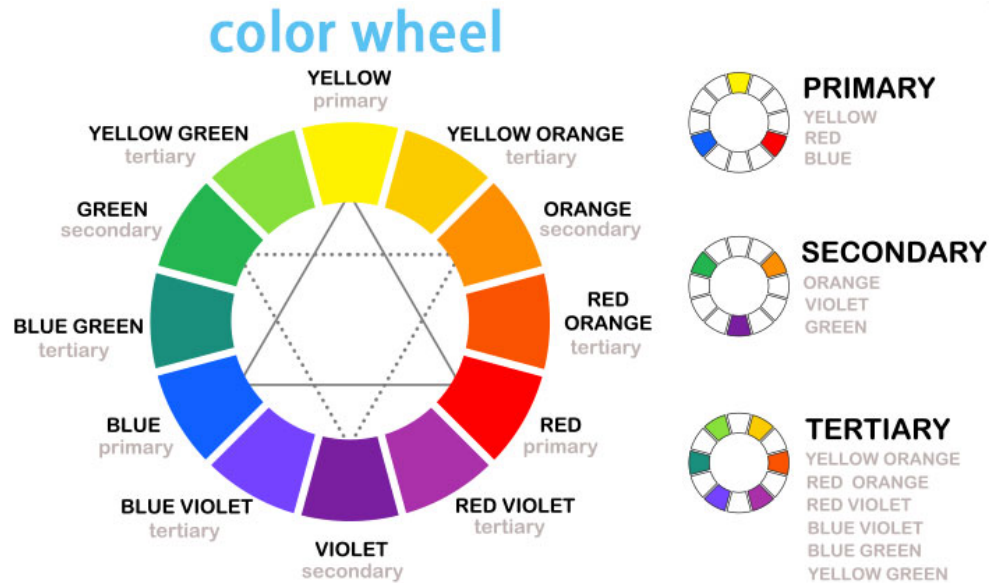
Supplies:

2 pipettes

Marker barrel ink cartridges

Cups

Your kit includes the ink cartridges from markers that were donated to ScrapsKC, but were dried up. These cotton inserts still have ink in them, and can be soaked in a bit of water to make it colorful!



Use the pipette and cups included to make some colors of water, then let your child squeeze the pipette under the water to draw some up and mix colors in the extra cups provided.

See what happens when you mix colors, or use plain water to practice fine motor skills by transferring water from one cup to another. Use the color wheel to explore warm colors, cool colors, complementing or contrasting colors, and make your own color theories as you experiment! This open ended creative play allows children to experiment, problem solve, and practice hand eye coordination.
